Elementary and Middle: Describe Pagoo, the Hermit Crab, in your Narration Notebook. Draw a picture of Pagoo.

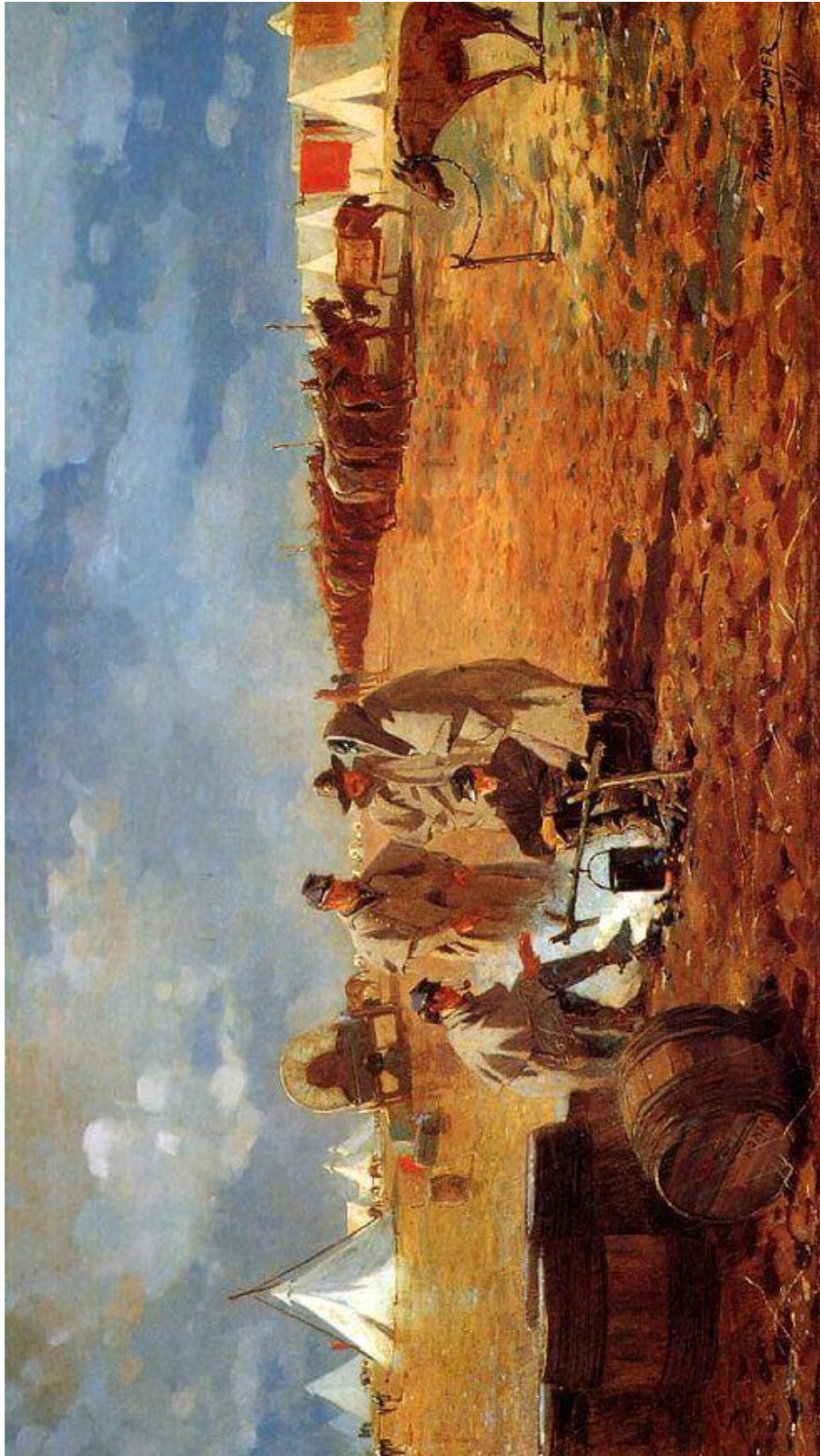
Middle: Read chapters III and IV in *The Young Citizen's Reader*. Describe "Nominations and Elections" in your own words.
