

BIBLE

GEOGRAPHY

NARRATION

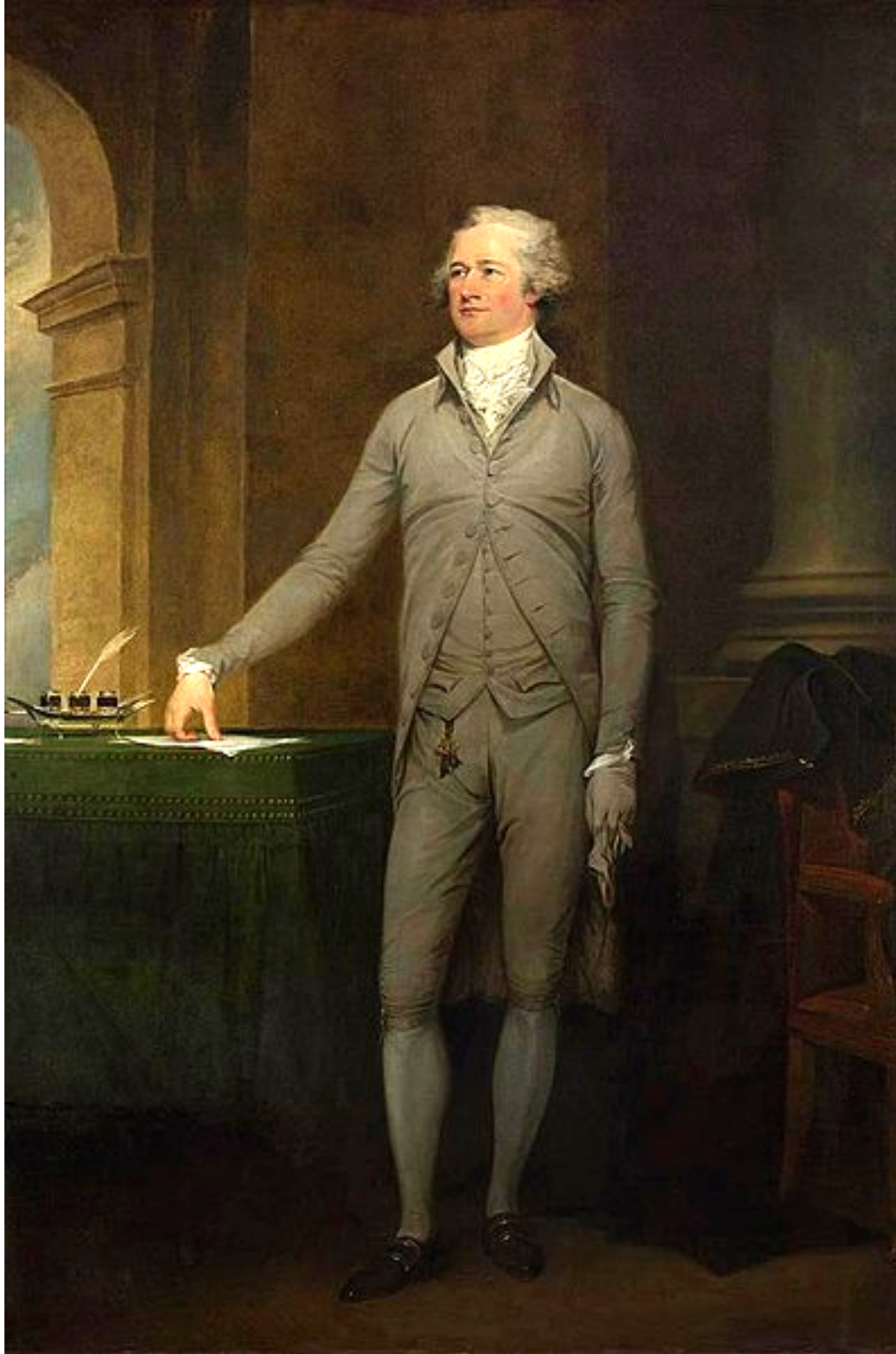
Describe Paul Revere's ride in your own words in your Narration Notebook. Draw a picture.
